

When do you need to see the ramp swing (8" to both right and left)

- Before the athlete's first throw when they are propelling the Jack:
 - first end = red swings ramp
 - second end = blue swings ramp, etc.
- Before a penalty shot
- In a tie breaker end, athletes must swing ramp prior to their first turn to throw. For pairs this is a simultaneous two-way swing (when it is their turn to throw).
- When returning from the court after viewing balls in play. For pairs this is a simultaneous two-way swing (when it is their turn to throw).

PENALTY IS A RETRACTION OF THROWN BALL

When do you NOT need to see the ramp swing?

- Blue does not need to swing ramp prior to throwing out first ball (providing that red has already thrown both jack and first red ball properly).
- If they don't have any more balls (when team mate goes out to court)
- In-between shots

Any athlete may swing their ramp when it is their turn and it is not necessary to do so.
