Competitor #s for athletes need to be on the front of the athlete or front of the wheelchair. Sport Assistants – no longer have competitor #s. BC3s will receive 2 competitor #s. Their Ramp Operators wear their #s on their back.

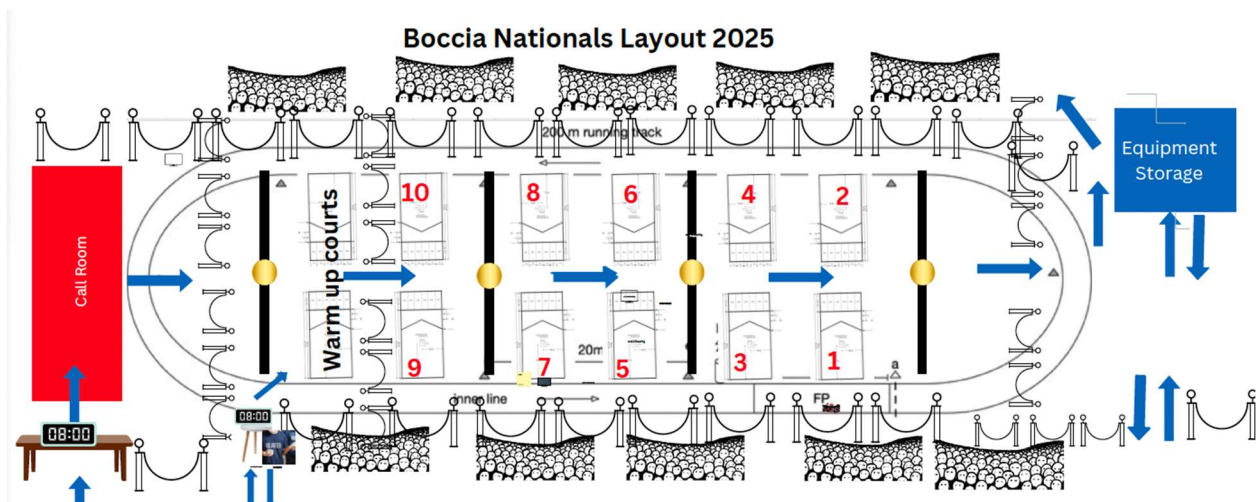
The official clock is at the call room desk. If you are still in line at the call room, you are on time

4.2.1 Competitors must be seated in a wheelchair to compete. Scooters may be used.

If you come into the call room without bocchia balls. There will be tournament balls in the call room that athletes can use. It could be a full set or replacement for missing balls. They must be returned at the end of the match.
