The following 9 athletes recently participated as part of the Boccia United States National Team and combined to receive 6 medals in all: Dylan Schneider (BC2), Wyatt Struxness (BC1), Deja Barber (BC2), Natalie Chastain and Becky Prince (BC3), Kalvin and Tony Blauert (BC3), Nick Taylor (BC4), Henry Sawyer (BC4). Deja Barber received an individual

silver medal, Wyatt Struxness received 4th in his division. Chastain, Prince, Kalvin and Tony Blauert combined forces to capture the silver medal in pairs. Taylor rounded out the medals while receiving his first individual medal in World Boccia with a bronze. Congratulations to all the athletes!
