

## National Championships 2027, 2028: RFP

**Background:** USA Boccia is the National Organization for the adaptive sport of boccia and a

major pipeline for the Paralympics. All athletes compete in wheelchairs and have a wide range of physical challenges. USA Boccia has hosted the National

Championship games since 2015.

**Bid Years:** Years: 2027, & 2028 (Single-year or Multi-year Bids acceptable)

**Bid Fee:** NO Bid fee is being required

**Venue** USA Boccia is seeking a ZERO-sum venue rental fee.

**Rental Parameters:** Defined as the RFP HOST can provide the venue free of charge through one of

the following methods: (1) Straight out rental & fee(s) waiver, (2) CVB Grant or

Sponsorship, or (3) Guaranteed third party sponsorship

**Event Dates Desired:** Please indicate the year you are bidding (may be more than one)

**Anticipated RFP Process** Applications open September 1st, and close Dec.1st, 2025 (and 2026)

**Timeframe**: Site Visits: to be planned in the year your application is processed.

**Days of Week:** Tournament: Tuesday/Wednesday through Sunday

**Number of Athletes:** 250 – all athletes compete in wheelchairs, Veterans, Paralympians & More

**Facility Requirement:** Must be ADA mobility (wheelchair) Friendly and Accessible.

(1) Minimum floor space 20,000 sq. ft. or more.

a. Roughly 4 full-sized basketball courts.

b. Air-conditioning is Mandatory.

c. Wide range of acceptable venues including civic arenas & conv ctr., college/HS venues, large Park & Rec facilities, Adaptive Sport

Facilities, etc

(2) Additional 3-5 separate rooms and or areas to host coaching, referee &

athlete sessions & lunches.

(3) One 5,000 sq. ft. + areas for annual meeting to hold at least 300 people



(4) Flooring: Must be smooth: wood (basketball court type preferred), rubber,

sport court, concrete possible

Flooring expense needs to be explicitly incorporated into venue cost.

**Airport:** Prefer to be within one hour of a major airport maximum.

**Transportation:** List transportation services for (1) wheelchair ADA & (2) able bodied from

airport to venue & hotels, and from hotels to venue. Identify if local public ADA

transportation services are available

**Hotel Requirements:** Majority of hotels must have a significant number of ADA MOBILITY rooms with specific wheelchair accessible (roll in) showers.

Provide Courtesy Blocks for Athletes

o Ability to provide FREE Protein Breakfast Buffets

o Provide \$10 per night per room night rebate to USA Boccia

**Average Length of Stay**: 4-6-night average per person

**Room Blocks Needed**: Average Total Room Nights used: 500-750

**Room Rate Average**: \$95-\$125 + tax, regardless of room capacity

**Hotel Pre-Registration**: Participants will make their own reservations and payments directly to the

hotel. Hotel reservations are not to be made though a National Reservations

Desk. The hotel room rate will include a "USA Boccia Discounted Rate". Rebates and Comp Rooms expected. (NOTE: Housing Services and /or

companies will not be utilized.)

Site Visit: RFP Bidder agrees that:

• A pre-decision site visit is required prior to final decision.

• Expenses to bring in site visit will be paid by RFP Bidder/Host City.

• Up to 3 room nights and 1 air flights via coach

 RFP Bidder will coordinate setting up site visit with meetings to include representatives from hotels, venue, Chamber of Commerce contact,

Visitor's Bureau contact, etc.

**Desired Services** Hosting Bidder will assist the local effort to:

 Recruit volunteers (approximately 15-20 per day) to assist with event operations



 Publicize our event / sport to school systems & public (online media and print, radio and TV) for FREE outreach participation activities

 Assist in setting up sponsorship opportunity connections & Chamber of Commerce speaking opportunities.

**Host City Contact:** There must be ONE LEAD speaker for the bid and signor of venue agreements

different from Lodging contacts.

**Local Support:** Prefer supporting letters for Bid to come from the following demonstrating

EACH of their organizations commitment to supporting Bid:

o President, Local Chamber of Commerce

o President, Major local University/college
