# Tournament Structure

The 2026 event will feature two new initiatives, splitting Boccia Sport Divisions (BC 1-6) into female and male divisions, and **PRIZE MONEY!**

Splitting into female and male divisions will be explained in more detail when the competition manual is released. If a Boccia Sport Division does not have enough females and males to be split into gendered divisions, they will play together, however, order of finish will still be split between female and male.

After 2026 Regionals conclude, Individual National Rankings will be split into genders. Ranking points already earned will be kept and transferred to your genders ranking.

Team and Pairs will be mixed genders and will have no gender requirements. Team and Pairs Registration will **ONLY** be conducted at Nationals.

Prize money will be awarded in individual (split by gender), pair, and team play to the top four finishers in each division. Each division will start off with a base of \$250 and then \$50 per athlete entered will be added to that division as well.

The funds for prize money came from restricted use grants and anonymous donors, the funds are not coming out of your entry fee.

## Transportation

If you require transportation, you must indicate what type of transportation on your registration form. If you (and anyone traveling with you) need a ride to and from the airport to the hotel, or daily from one of the preferred hotels to the venue and back, the cost is \$50.00 per person for the duration of the competition.

## STEP 2-Register

When registering, be prepared to answer these questions:

- Who is your Coach
- Who is your Team Leader
- If you use a ramp, who is your Ramp Operator?
- If you have a BC1 classification, who is your Sport Assistant?
- Boccia Sport Division (I need classification/Assessment, BC1-BC6, N/A)
- Transportation needs
- Be ready to make your payment

## STEP 3-Initiate Classification if Required

Athletes who are required to be classified **MUST** complete the process to be eligible to compete. Classification is required for athletes attending nationals for the first time OR any athlete who does not have a Confirmed status and is currently in Review. Classification is a procedure in which medical and technical classifiers assess an athlete's physical function and place them into a sport class.

1. Complete both the Authorization Form and the Diagnosis Form

Forms must be submitted **NO LATER than Wednesday, July 1, 2026.**

2. Scan both forms into one single PDF.
3. Email the PDF to Dr. Kathy Brinker at [kathyb@bocciaunitedstates.org](mailto:kathyb@bocciaunitedstates.org)
4. In your email, please include your availability window for classification on Wednesday, July 29 between 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Example: "I am available between 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM.". We will do our best to accommodate your requested time.
5. Once your email is received, you will receive an email from Kathy Brinker confirming your classification time and additional instructions.
